Panora Telco College Scholarship Program 2018

In 2018, Panora Telco will award (2) \$500 scholarships to Panorama high school seniors.

Eligibility Applicants must:

- Be a graduating Panorama high school senior.
- Be accepted by an accredited two or four year college or university, or vocational-technical school.
- Have at least a C grade point average. Please note this is not a scholarship based on a 4.0 average, but is awarded to deserving students whose academic credentials fall within an average to above average range

How to Apply

- Complete the scholarship application in full.
- **Prepare a 150 to 350 word essay on the following topic:**
 - 1) How has having access to the internet changed (enhanced) your educational experience?
- Have two (2) high school educators complete the Educator's Form. Each must be sent in a sealed envelope from the author.
- Include your most recent grade transcript (All seven semesters must be represented.) If available, include test scores and/or class rank with the transcript.

Award Procedure:

- The \$500 scholarships will be awarded at the Panorama Seniors Awards Night.
- Winner will be selected by an independent, qualified committee.
- All entries must be received by **Friday, April 20, 2018, 12 NOON. No late applications will be accepted.**
- Scholarships will be awarded on a onetime basis and will not be renewable.
- Award will be paid upon proof of registration at an institute of higher education, and will be payable the second term.
- Scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, sex or disability.

Incomplete applications will not be considered. Make sure to:

- Include your application form.**
- Attach your transcript.**
- Attach your essay.**
- Attach your 2 Educator's Forms in sealed envelopes.**
- Return your entry by April 20, 2018, 12 NOON.**
